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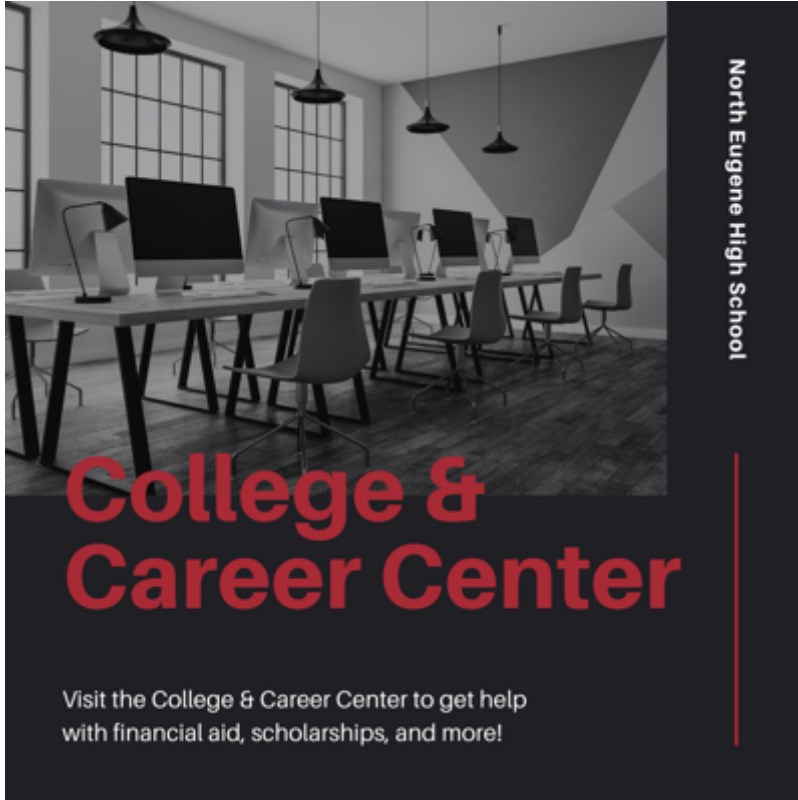

In our Advisory classes this past Friday, all teachers reviewed with students the variety of safety expectations we have at North. **What is the goal of FOCUS homework club?**



The goal of FOCUS homework club is to support students after school by providing tutoring, positive encouragement, and a designated space to complete assignments in a supervised setting. FOCUS homework is supervised by a licensed teacher, an educational assistant, and peer tutors. Ninth grade students are invited to attend FOCUS to complete missing assignments or improve their grades. FOCUS homework club meets Monday, Tuesday, and Thursday from 3:45-4:45 pm after school in room 115 (math/access center). FOCUS homework club begins Monday, September 26th, 2022.
