IB Exam Registration

IB registration season is here! 11th and 12th grade parents, if your student is interested in taking an IB exam this May, please be sure to fill out the correct registration form (see below) by November 1. Students who receive a passing score on their exams and complete all required coursework can earn between 4-12 college credits per subject! The cost for each exam is \$100, and we can accept cash, SchoolPay, or checks made out to North Eugene High School. If your family qualifies for the Free and Reduced Lunch program, there is no cost to test. 
